Maundy Thursday Stations of Prayer

Thursday, March 24, at 12 Noon and 7 PM

Both services will celebrate communion and will be anchored by prayer stations in several areas of the church...the Border Chapel, the Art Gallery, Carlson Hall and the Sanctuary. Similar to the Stations of the Cross, worshippers will read scripture and pray at stations with a photograph or piece of art that represents our Lenten theme of "Into Your Hands." Each station has been created by Hennepin artists and members. The noon service will end in the Border Chapel for communion and the 7:00 service will end in the Sanctuary. Both services will begin in the East Entrance with a beginning prayer and blessing. At the evening service, various musicians will be in the worship spaces offering the gift of music during our prayer. Please join us for this important time in our walk in Holy Week.

The ancient Tenebrae service is one of the most moving and dramatic of the Church Year. The word "Tenebrae" is Latin for "shadows." The service begins with the sanctuary brilliantly lighted.
