Hennepin Church has a long history of work in Haiti. Today, we will celebrate our breadfruit project. Our Christmas Offering this year will be to the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) to fund the ongoing response to the recent destruction and death caused by Hurricane Matthew in Haiti.

The provision of emergency supplies, food, health kits, and other assistance builds on UMCOR's sustained presence in Haiti, work that has continued since the disastrous earthquake in January 2010. More than 500 deaths in Haiti have been attributed to Hurricane Matthew.

The UMCOR response includes emergency supplies, a water purification program done in partnership with GlobalMedic, and an additional food-distribution program through the Haitian church. UMCOR has long collaborated with both GlobalMedic and the church.
