Construction Update

Lower Level of Education Wing

Demo work is nearly complete. Demo should be wrapped up on Monday, 7/24. Some framing work has started in areas where possible

First Floor of Education Wing

Demo will restart when the Lower Level is completed. Framing has been underway in areas where demo work has been completed.

Kitchen

The electrical and plumbing fixtures have all been disconnected. Work in the kitchen will start full bore once the demo in the education wing is completed.

Exterior Restoration

Scaffolding started to be set on Wednesday. Scaffold setting will continue for the next two weeks. In the meantime, sample cuts, mortar samples, caulking samples, etc. will be worked through and approved while scaffolding is being set in place.

Of other note, the Building Committee has been working on building a system to get more volunteer help with the remainder of the demo work. "Site Leaders" will be trained in safety practices and told what specific jobs need to be done. Work shifts of 2 hours will be set up for dates and times Site Leaders are available to be present and direct workers.
