Help us, O God, to be people who give of ourselves.

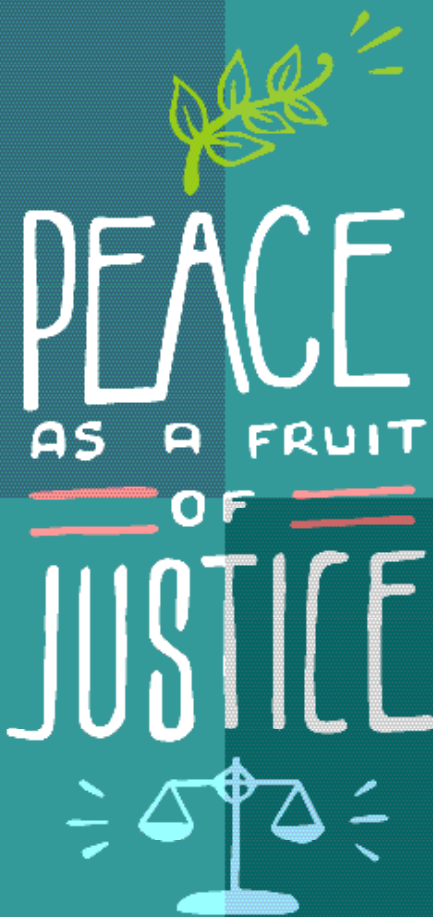
God calls us to love our neighbors, to walk alongside them in the mess of life. Yet, many of us hardly know the people who live and work near us.

God calls us to seek justice, yet we are tempted to pacify, placate or ignore rather than face the hard realities that others face in the world around us.

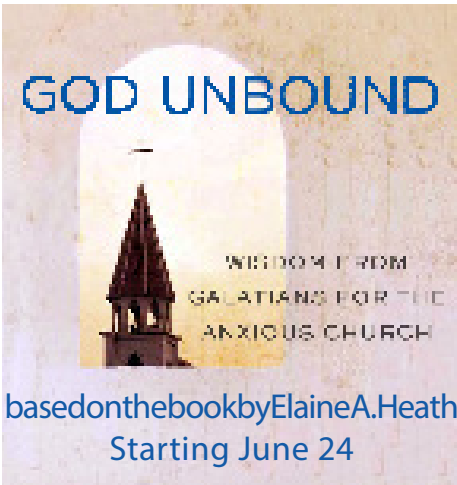
Loving God, grant us compassion to carry the peace of Christ into the world. Amen.
