Today, 11:15 am in the Harrison Room

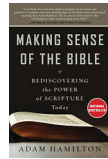

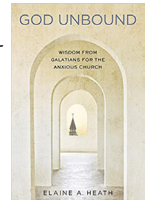
Volunteer for Twin Cities Pride
